

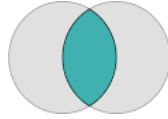


Fish Symbols



When two Christians met, one person drew half a basic fish shape (often using their foot in the dust on the ground) and the other person drew the other half of the fish. The Greek word for fish is 'Ikthus' or 'Ichthys'. There are five Greek letters in the word. It can also make up a sentence of Christian beliefs 'Ie-sous Christos Theou Huios So-te-r' which in English means "Jesus Christ, Son of God, Saviour".

2 = **Union** – Division / Divide (break) – **Separation**; 13 = **Apostasy** – Rebellion (anger) – **Lawlessness** – **Sin** – Satan; 26 = The **Gospel of Christ**; 37 = The **Word of God** – The Godhead – God's Attributes – **Chosen Servant** – Exaltation; and, 73 = Babylon (World Rule).

In these meanings, we see the Union that originally existed at Creation, then world rebellion and apostasy against God and Christ. This occurs throughout the sin period, to a time where, by allegiance to the Bible, God's chosen servants are exalted.

Now consider the Gematria of the Hebrew of Genesis 1:1 and its meaning:

the earth	and	the heaven (untranslated)	God	created	In the beginning	
296	407	395	401	86	203	913

Using **Gematria**, the sum of 913+203+86+401+395+407+296 = **2,701 = 37x73**, where in Hebrew, **Jesus=37** and **Christ=73**

Here, again we have the prime and reflective numbers of **37** and **73**.

Note also that: $913 \times 203 \times 86 \times 401 \times 395 \times 407 \times 296 = 304,153,525,784,175,760$

where $304 + 153 + 525 + 784 + 175 + 760 = 2,701$ (**37 x 73**)

and $3 + 0 + 4 + 1 + 5 + 3 + 5 + 2 + 5 + 7 + 8 + 4 + 1 + 7 + 5 + 7 + 6 + 0 = 73$

Also 304, 153, 525, 784, 175, 760 when digitally summed

$= 7 + 9 + 12 + 19 + 13 + 13 = 73$

and, when digitally summed again $= 7 + 9 + 3 + 10 + 4 + 4 = 37$

Likewise, consider the 2701 and its 1072 reflection = $2701+1072 = 3773 = 3 \times 543$

In Hebrew, **543 = I AM that I AM** and as a Biblical number it means I Turn My Back on Evil Men.

The reciprocal of **3773** is $1/3773 =$ which is a decimal having **294** [infinitely] repeating digits.

In Hebrew, **294 = Lord Jesus Christ** and as a Biblical number it means **Spirit of Wisdom**.

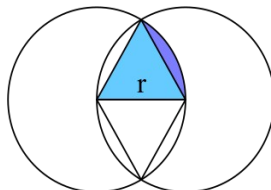
Also, 294's infinitely repeating digital sum = **1323** which is $(3 \times 7 \times 7 \times 3) + (3 \times 7 \times 7 \times 3) + (3 \times 7 \times 7 \times 3)$.

Furthermore, $2701 \times 1072 = 2,895,472$ where $2 + 8 + 9 + 5 + 4 + 7 + 2 = 37$

And $2+895+472 = 1369 = 37 \times 37$ with $1 + 369 = 370$

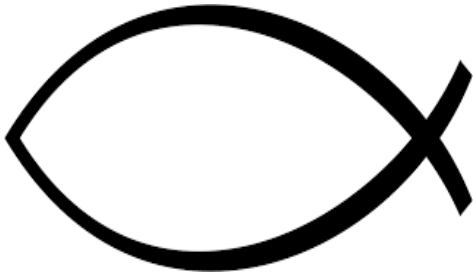


Vesica Piscis: -



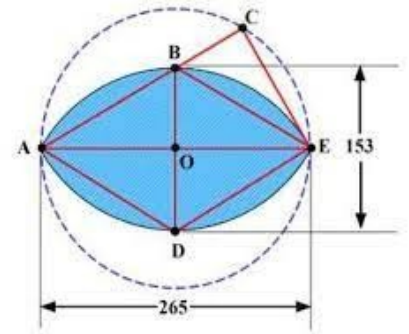
The areas in blue – an equilateral triangle and a segment – form together a sector of one sixth of the circle (60°)

Now lets look more closely at the Fish Symbol:



Take 2 same sized circles and overlap them half way; this forms the **Vesica piscis**.

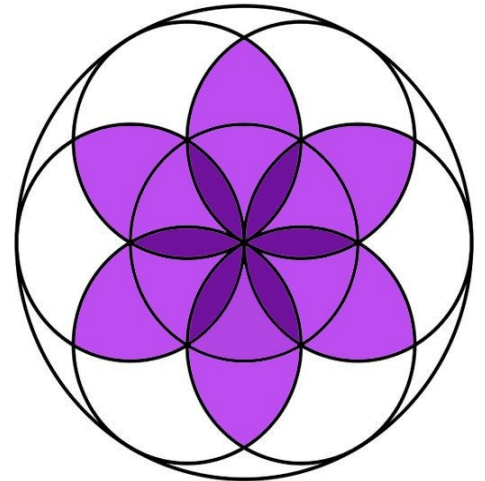
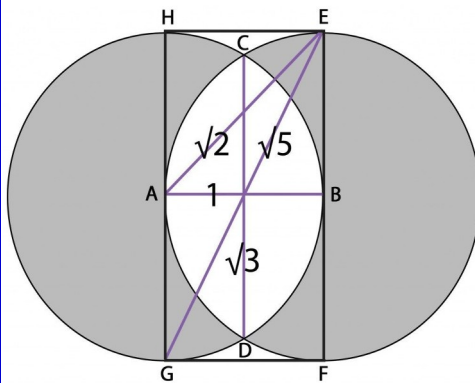
The basic shape = 265 x 153
 153 is the sum of the first factorials
 = 1! + 2! + 3! + 4! + 5!
 = 1 + 2 + 6 + 24 + 120 = 153

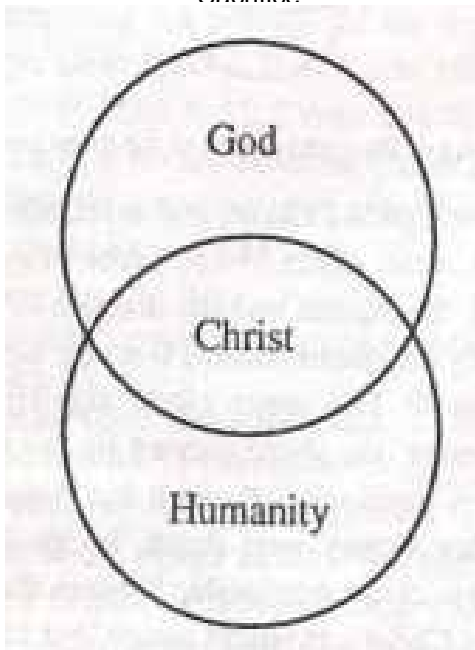


John 21:11 **Simon Peter went up, and drew the net to land full of great fishes, an hundred and fifty and three: and for all there were so many, yet was not the net broken.**

In the meaning of Biblical Numbers: **265** = No Place to Lay your Head **153** = Tribe of Believers – Fruit Bearing
 9 = Fruits of God's Holy Spirit – Hour of Prayer – Divine Completeness from the Father – Finality – Unchangeableness – Judgement (Spirit of truth)
 17 = Overcoming the Enemy – Complete victory (sword of the Lord) – Perfection of Spiritual Order – Goodness and Sacrifice

The early church used the first two letters of Christos in the Greek alphabet 'chi' and 'rho' to create a monogram (symbol) to represent the name of Jesus. This looks like an X with a small p on the top: 

John 1:12 **But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, [even] to them that believe on his name:**

The above example for 84 also works for any random positive integer, divisible by three.



Romans 8:14 **For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the SONS of GOD.**

$153 = 1^3 + 5^3 + 3^3 = 1^{\{3\}} + 5^{\{3\}} + 3^{\{3\}}$. Thus it is a 3-narcissistic number.

Philippians 2:15 **That ye may be blameless and harmless, the SONS of GOD, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world:**

153 is also the smallest three-digit number which can be expressed as the sum of cubes of its digits.

Note that:

1 John 3:1 **Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the SONS of GOD: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.**

Only five other numbers can be expressed as the sum of the cubes of their digits: 0, 1, 370, 371 and 407.

Colossians 1:16 **For by him were ALL THINGS created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether [they be] thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:**

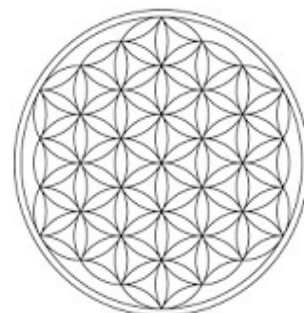
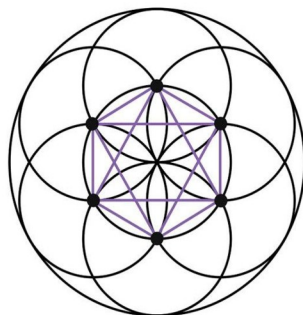
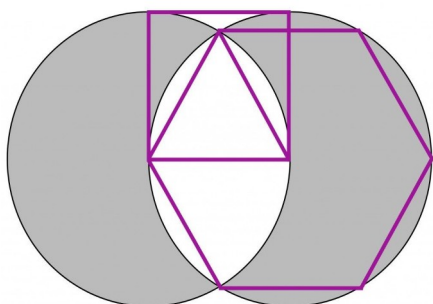

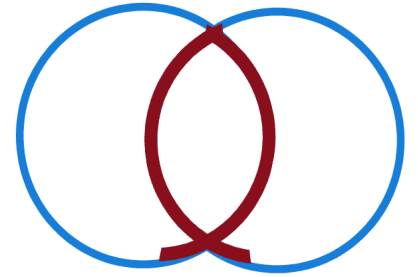
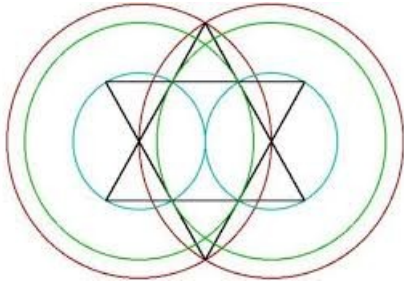
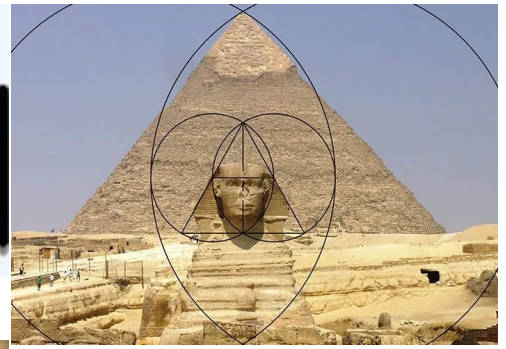
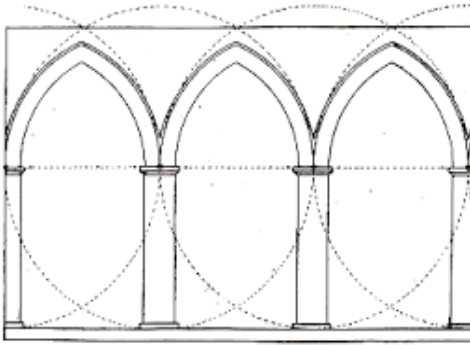
153 is also a Friedman number, since $153 = 3 \times 51$.

Conclusion

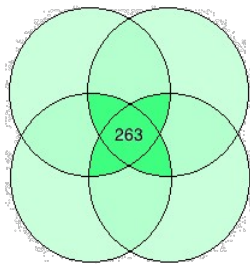




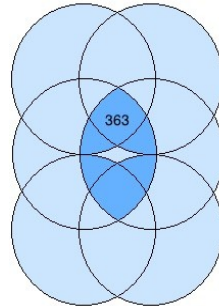
By increasing the number of circles involved, we can produce intersections geometrically related to the vesica piscis. Some of these have areas that are also found as gematria related to Jesus Christ.

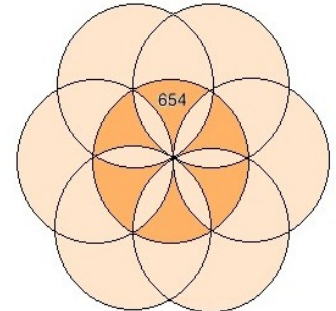
FOUR INTERSECTING CIRCLES OF AREA 1000 UNITS



263 = Messiah [s]

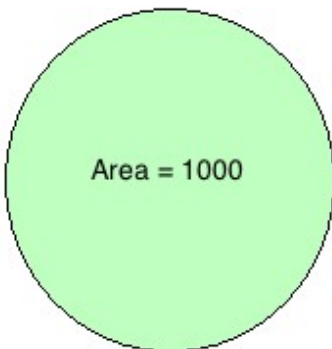

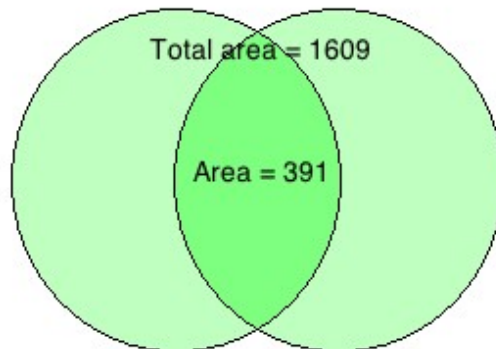

391 = Holy One of God is Killed (Faith in Christ)

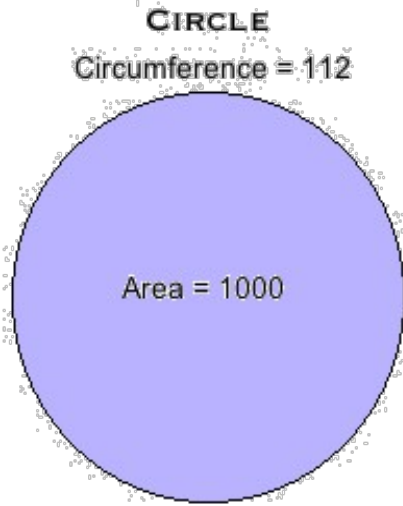

If we now calculate the circumference of the starting circle (area 1000 units), we make another divine connection, with the Hebrew words Yahweh Elohim, translated as 'The Lord God' and first found in Genesis 2.4.

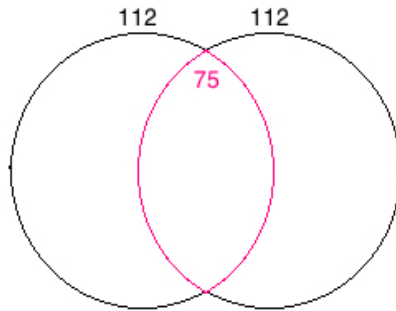
The circumference of the vesica obtained from this circle is 75 units, the ordinal value of 'Lord God', and the total circumference of both intersecting circles, including the vesica, is 224, the value of an alternative spelling of Ruach, Hebrew for 'Spirit'.

We can begin with a circle of any size, of course, and if we create a circle such that the vesica made by the intersection of two such circles has a half circumference of 391 units. This is an arc of the circle itself and the diameter of that circle is 373 units. The number 373 is the gematria of the Greek word logos, meaning 'Word'.

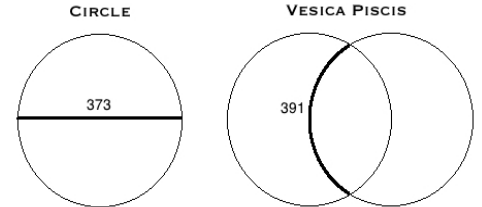

So the proportions of the vesica piscis link the names 'Yehoshua' and 'Logos' and support the opening statements in the Gospel of John that Jesus is the Word made flesh (John 1.14).

The Greek New Testament mostly uses the name Ihsous Christos for Jesus Christ, with gematria 2368. If we construct two circles, one with a circumference of 2368 units, and the other with an area of 2368 square units, we find that the Hebrew and English names for Jesus Christ are automatically generated. The names in all three languages, Ihsous Christos, Yehoshua HaMashiach and Jesus Christ, along with their numerical values under the standard value system of numeration, applied in the same way to all three alphabets, is given below.

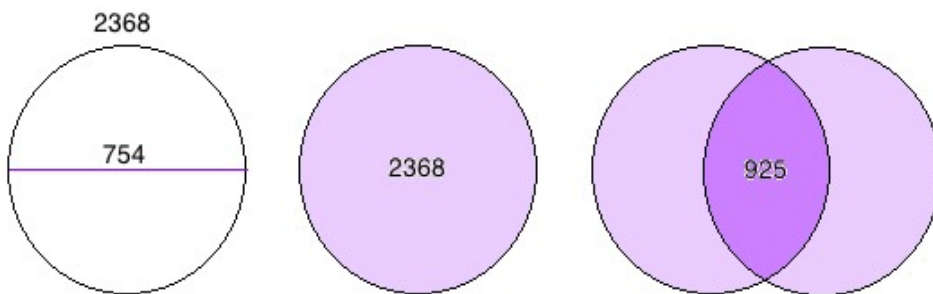
Jesus Christ = 2368 (Greek)

Jesus the Messiah = 754 (Hebrew)

Jesus Christ (s) = 925

Both 754 and 925 can be derived from 2368 by making 2368 the circumference of a circle then calculating the diameter, and by making 2368 the area of a circle then creating a vesica piscis from it.

Note: The area of the vesica is 925.8, which should actually round up to 926.

Because it is otherwise such a compelling relationship, supported by the other numerical relationships detailed here, and because there is a tradition of coel in Kabbalah, meaning that plus or minus one digit is allowed, since "each number contains the seed of the next".

Conclusion

Once again we see the nomenclature of the divine embodying fundamental mathematical truths. The form of the vesica piscis and its proportions, built into the names and titles by which we know Jesus Christ have a symbolic message for us. The intersecting circles portray the same image as the intersecting triangles in a Star of David, that of heaven meeting earth in the Son of God.
